# Savor the beauty of Marblehead's Little Harbor & its two island gems



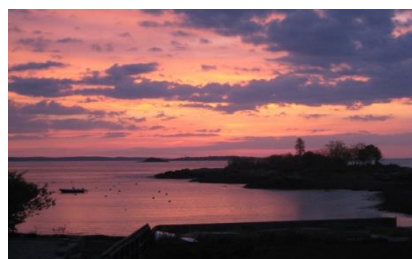
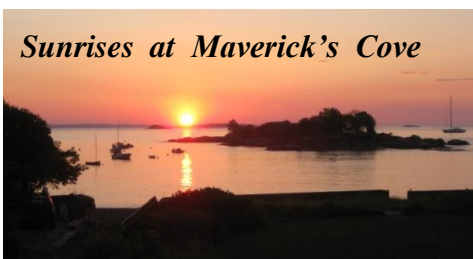
Discover unfamiliar stories about these exquisite coastal zones & learn about preservation of these priceless open spaces

Little Harbor's two off-shore islands are preserved as natural open spaces in perpetuity due to their donations in 2018 & 1955 to the Trustees of Reservations, which manages nearly 120 miles of coastline in MA and nearly the same number of total properties in the state.



**Crowninshield Island** (formerly Brown's) was given by Louise DuPont Crowninshield in 1955. **Gerry's Island** was donated by Ted & Julie Moore in 2018. An endowment for ongoing preservation of both islands was raised by contributions to the Trustees from many people.
